- **Meeting minutes from the last Town Board meeting (3/18/2026) were accepted.**

- **Supervisors Comments:** The Supervisor remarked on several items –
 - i. Preparation of town fields for the spring sports season underway
 - ii. Fencing improvements ongoing at Stringham Park
 - iii. Senior Drop-in Center set to open – see Public Comments for details
 - iv. Town is actively working on a county MID grant and plans to apply for a newly announced Veterans Micro Grant.
 - v. Establishment of a Veterans Affairs Advisory Committee; appointment of a chairman discussed later in the meeting.

- Consideration of RFP for Sludge Removal: Noxon Knolls and Titusville WWTP – (Waste Water Treatment Plants)
 - Three bids reviewed. Contract awarded to Wind River, estimated to save ~\$1,360/month (\$16,000+ annually).
- Consideration of Fee Waiver Request for use of Freedom Park: Arlington Alumni Association - Approved waiver of \$380 fee for use of Freedom Park on June 18th for annual alumni picnic.
- Consideration of a Request from the Tax Receiver to attend NYS Association of Tax Receivers & Collectors Training in Niagara Falls, NY from 6/7 to 6/10/2026 - Approved. Note: Tax Dept is transitioning to new KBS platform

- Consideration of Appointment of a Chairman for the LaGrange Veterans Advisory Committee - Victor Zamaloff – Approved
- Consideration of a Stipend for the Town Clerk - Councilperson Giangrasso made a motion for \$1,250/year stipend for Christine for Agenda Preparation – it is not usual part of her work workload. - Approved.
- Consideration of Bid Proposal Packet for Tree Clearing for the Manchester Water District Tank Site off Red Oaks Mill Road – Accepted
- Consideration of Approval of a Revised Building and Fire Prevention Fee Schedule - Increases proposed after consultation with the building department and other towns. - Approved.
- Consideration of Approval of the Senior Drop-in -Center Policy & Procedures Manual - Approved manual in preparation for Senior Center opening.
